First of all, we are pleased to once again be offering an EHS SAT After-School Workshop. Come join us after school on Wednesdays in March for **free** guided practice on each of the main sections of the SAT. Sessions will be led by Eisenhower teachers Michelle Schuchard and Andy Bulat and will last **from 2:30-4:00 in the ECC at Eisenhower on March 6, 13, 20, and 27**. Participants should bring a pencil, pen, and notepad to each session. No registration is required for these particular sessions, but students should be aware that food and drink are not allowed in the ECC.
