

Good morning Eagle 11th grader and family.

On **Tuesday, January 26, 2021** we will deviate from the usual cohort schedule due to PSAT/NMSQT Testing. This will impact JUNIORS ONLY.

Juniors who made the selection to take the test back in October will report to school.

Juniors who did not opt to take the test will remain at home for remote learning regardless of their alphabetical cohort.

If you selected to take the test, you will receive a follow up communication with further Test Day instructions. Unfortunately, the test roster is firmly established and we are not able to add testers.

Fourth and fifth hours will be asynchronous learning for all juniors as many of our junior teachers will be administering the PSAT assessment. Students will be expected to complete work posted on Schoology and provided by their teacher. Juniors who are testing will not be able to attend TEAMS classes for 4th and 5th hours. Juniors NOT testing are still welcome to join a TEAMS class if there is one being offered. Teachers will let students know what 4th and 5th period classes will look like on this day ahead of time.

Sixth hour will be synchronous learning for all juniors since testing will be over by that time. Thus, ALL juniors will need to log-on to their 6th period TEAMS class. Sixth hour starts at 12:24 p.m.

With the exception of students who are taking the PSAT/NMSQT with accommodations, all CSI/MST students who opted to take the test will be testing at IRC. Mr. Paulon will send an email with Test Day Instructions.
